



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) entered into this 1st Dec 2023, by and between K. C. Law College & Maharashtra Human Rights Commission. Both the parties desire to establish academic and research collaborations on areas related to Human Rights, & Research with each other to share a common interest in academic and educational fields for the betterment of society.

Now therefore, it is mutually agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Objectives: To develop and carry out the collaborative activities for the benefits of students, academia and society at large.

2. Scope of Activities: It is pertaining to academic and research related collaborative activities including:

- i. Student Internships
- ii. Joint research or project pertaining to Human Rights
- iii. Organizing symposia, seminars, conferences and workshops on Human Rights
- iv. Joint programme(s) for education and awareness relating to human rights
- v. Pursuit of consulting and project opportunities




3. Not Legally Binding: Both the parties, H.S.N.C Board's Kishinchand Chellaram Law College (K. C. Law College) AND Maharashtra State Human Rights Commission agree that this MoU is not intended to create any legally binding effect, whatsoever and also agree that signing of this MoU does not result in any material, financial or any other obligation whatsoever of either of the parties hereto and this MoU shall not create any financial burden on the Maharashtra State Human Rights Commission. This MoU is intended to signify the desires of both the parties for future collaboration which may include specific initiatives towards considered and agreed upon on a case to case basis including the contributions and duties of both the parties. Further, both the parties agree that in furtherance and pursuance of this MoU, subsidiary MoUs may be signed and executed as and when required.


4. Terms: This MoU shall be in force and shall be valid for a duration of Five (05) years from the date of commencement of the MoU which shall mean the date on which the MoU shall be signed by the parties to the MoU. This MoU may be extended or amended with the written consent of both the parties and may be terminated by either party with one month written notice to the other party.

5. Counterparts: This MoU may be executed in any number of counterparts with the same effects as if all the parties had all signed the same document. All counterparts will be construed together and will constitute one and the same MoU.
