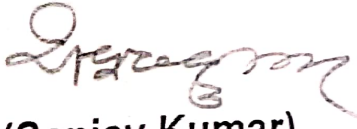

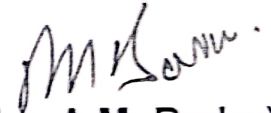

ORDER

1. Considering the importance of the matter, it is heard by the Division bench of this Commission.
2. Shri. Prashant Balu Narawade, Block Development Officer, Akkalkuva, Nandurbar is present. Shri. Pramod Bhamare, Dy. Collector, Nandurbar, Shri. Mayur Vasave, Executive Engineer, PWD, Shahada, Shri. Manoj Chaudhary, Asst. Commissioner, Divisional Commissioner present through Video Conferencing.
3. The proceedings are initiated suo moto on the basis of report in the newspaper Lokmat. The report mentions that as there is no bridge on the river adjacent to the village Kelkhadi in Tal Akalkuva of District Nandurbar, students are required to go to the School by travelling from the branch of the tree with the help of a rope.

4. We are glad to note that even without notice from this Commission, the authorities of the State Government have acted promptly and taken care of this issue as seen from the report submitted by the Collector, Nandurbar. It is seen from the said report that in response to the newspaper report, the Executive Engineer, Public Works Department, Shahada has visited the spot. It was seen from the report that Kelkhadi is a village situated in a remote area of Akalkuva Taluka and non-planned road is available only up to village Guliamba. From that village Zilla Parishad School is at a distance of 2 kms. In between, river runs and because of that during rainy season people had to cross that spot with the help of the branch of the tree. However, upon noticing this situation for safety of the residents, an iron bridge on Kelkhadi River came to be proposed and this work is effected by seeking administration approval from the District Planning Committee, Nandurbar. Shri. Pramod Bhamare, Dy. Collector has informed that the work of the construction of the iron bridge is already over and the same bridge is in use of the residents.
5. The Commission appreciate the promptness shown by the authorities of the State in redressal of grievance of the students as well as the residents of the remote locality of tribals of Tal Akalkuva in the State.
6. No further action is violated in the instant case and the case is closed and disposed of.
7. Inform to all the parties concerned.
